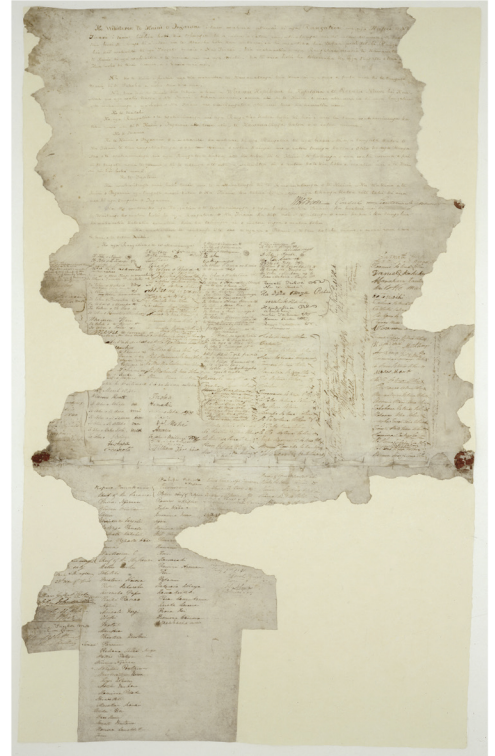
PROGRAMME:
